

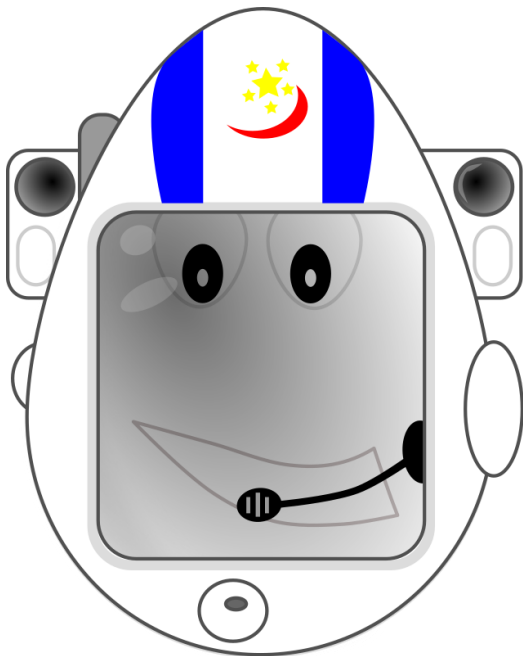
An Egg-ceptional Parent Visitation Day
